Wolston Farmhouse is part of the National Trust of Australia Queensland (NTAQ), being one of twelve heritage sites throughout Queensland. The National Trust Australia Queensland is currently seeking a multi-skilled hospitality all-rounder to assist with site operations of Wolston Farmhouse "Tea Terrace" & event business. The successful applicant will be someone that can ensure the property is well presented and organised, and be hands-on in hospitality operations to deliver a warm welcome to guests, showcasing this heritage attraction of Greater Brisbane. This role would suit a previous café owner or experienced hospitality supervisor.

Position details & duties

- Ability to work independently and coordinate the daily operations of the Wolston Farmhouse property & Tea Terrace, including cash control and emergency procedures.
- Provide guidance and experience to existing staff & volunteers.
- Experience in taking the lead and working efficiently under pressure.
- Provide warm and friendly customer service and share the history of the property.
- Prepare and serve a basic café-style menu which includes our famous farmhouse scones.
- Maintain standards of hygiene for food handling and presentation whilst using safe work practices.
- Perform daily property open/close duties and assist with any event operations.
- The role will include cleaning duties including dish room duties associated with the Tea Terrace.
- You will work independently in this role with support from the Property Manager and assisted by dedicated team of property volunteers.
- This role will typically be working Friday Sunday from 10.00 am -4.00pm on a Casual basis, but this
 may increase & occasional evening work may be required subject to business growth
- Pay and work conditions are under the Amusements, Events & Recreation Award 2010.
- Non-smokers are preferred.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. A minimum of 2 years' experience in a cafe or restaurant establishment will be highly regarded.
- 2. Must be self-directed with excellent time management and ability to work calmly under pressure.
- 3. Friendly personal interaction skills required to deliver excellent customer service and work harmoniously and productively with the staff and volunteer teams.
- 4. Ability to provide information to guests about the history of the property and its occupants in a clear, interesting and memorable manner. Training will be provided.
- 5. A current Qld Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) is desirable.
- 6. You must be available to work each Friday, Saturday and Sunday between 10am-4pm.
- 7. You must have your own reliable transport.
- 8. Barista experience preferred but not essential.
- 9. You will have appropriate personal presentation to work in a heritage environment.
- 10. Role requires average level of fitness, including the ability to lift up to 10 kg and perform bending and twisting.
- 11. First Aid certificate is preferred.
