## Key position details & duties:

The role of Photographic 2IC is a hands-on supervisory and photography sales position. You will provide back up and leadership support to the Photography Supervisor in all aspects of running this busy department. You will be required to have genuine Team Leadership skills. The role is to work with staff members to ensure they produce and sell professional quality photography products. Your own photographic experience is important as you should be able to capture a visitor's happy memories of their experience interacting with our Wildlife at the Sanctuary. You must ensure all team members deliver a high level of customer service and a fun photographic experience.

- This is a full time role working 38 hours per week.
- Rostered working day will be Tuesday Saturday. May be subject to change based on the business needs.
- The successful applicant may be required to provide a satisfactory police check clearance.
- Pay and work conditions are under the Amusements, Events & Recreation Award 2010.
- This role will involve outdoor work.

- 3. Experience working in a production mini lab is highly desirable.
- 4. Has natural ability to transform each guest interaction into a positive & friendly photographic experience.
- 5. Has proven ability to generate sales, can up sell & reach sales targets whilst motivating & driving the Team to achieve these same results.
- 6. Able to work independently, quickly & efficiently with superior time management skills.
- 7. Ability to remain calm in high pressure situations.
- 8. Shows initiative in problem solving & demonstrates a positive 'Can-Do' attitude.
- 9. Is comfortable working with all Wildlife, including birds and reptiles.
- 10. You will have a high standard of personal presentation, customer service and fitness. You must be able to walk long distances and carry up to 10 kg.
