Key position details & duties

- Provide a warm, friendly and welcoming style of service to all guests.
- This is a fast paced role providing friendly food & beverage counter service, basic food preparation and assisting with in park events.
- The role will include cleaning duties such as table clearing, ensuring courter areas are well
 presented and refreshed & assisting with dish room duties as required.
- Maintain standards of hygiene for food handling and presentation.
- Promote a safe workplace by recognising hazards and promoting general WHS practises.
- Barista and RSA skills would be considered an advantage.
- Full availability over Qld and NSW School Holiday periods is essential.
- This is a casual position with hours of work ranging from Monday to Sunday on a rotating roster. We cannot guarantee hours, but expect weekly hours to range from 10 24 hours.
- Pay and work conditions are under the Amusements, Events & Recreation Award 2010.
- The successful applicant may be required to provide a satisfactory police check clearance.
- You must be comfortable working in an outdoor environment that includes birds and reptiles.
- Non-smokers are preferred.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Previous experience in a customer service role, ideally within a Fast Food, cafe or restaurant establishment.
- 2. A current Qld Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) Competency Card/Certificate is essential or willingness to obtain.
- 3. Hours of work: Hospitality hours availability required between typically 7.00 a.m. 9.00pm over 7 day roster. Own transport may therefore be required.
- 4. Barista experience is desirable but not essential.
- 5. High standard of personal presentation and communication.
- 6. Excellent customer service skills, including cash handling and up-selling ability.
- 7. Flexible approach to work, as this position will involve working across different outlets and different work teams within the Food & Beverage and Events department.
- 8. You must be a hardworking, friendly & cooperative person: a 'can-do' attitude is a key part of the job.
- 9. Must be self-directed with excellent time management and ability to work calmly under pressure.
- 10. Knowledge of the attractions of Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary is desirable.
