National Trust – Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary are seeking an enthusiastic, capable and reliable person to fill the role of Park Cleaner on a casual basis. This role will require you to take responsibility for undertaking specialized cleaning tasks to maintain the cleanliness of both indoor and outdoor areas of Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary. Weekend work will be required so the applicant will need to have seven day availability.

Position details & duties

- Responsible for physical cleaning of Sanctuary's facilities, toilets, public areas plus internal offices, kitchens, food and beverage outlets, lunch rooms and other areas.
- This role will require extensive walking, bending, lifting and carrying, in an outdoor environment, in all weathers.
- This role will require performing other duties as required by the Cleaning department.
- A key part of this role is to provide friendly helpful information about the Sanctuary facilities and attractions to our visitors.
- Safe use of equipment and proper use of personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Adhere to company policies and procedures relating to Workplace Health & Safety.
- Hours of work are between 5.30 am to 9.30 am OR 5.30am to 12:00pm.
- Pay rate & conditions are under the Amusements, Events & Recreation Award 2010.
- Non-smoker preferred.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Previous experience with working productively within a small team must be a cooperative team player, able to follow direction without supervision and demonstrate initiative to complete job tasks.
- 2. Has physical fitness to work outdoors in all weathers, walk long distances, carry a backpack of 30Kg for prolonged periods, empty bins, work with chemicals and capably perform all elements of a cleaning role.
- 3. At least one year of relevant experience in similar role or commercial cleaning would be an advantage
- 4. Ability to adhere to W.H.S guidelines/policies and practices. Experience in working safely with commercial chemicals is an advantage.
- 5. Appropriate level of English and Numeracy skills is required.
- 6. Has acceptable level of personal presentation and communication to be able to interact in a friendly, professional and courteous manner with Park visitors, staff and volunteers. Must be able to read, speak and write English to a high level to deliver appropriate levels of customer service.
- 7. Must hold current Driver's licence. First Aid qualifications will be highly regarded
- 8. Must have availability to work weekends and over all holiday periods.
- 9. The successful candidate may be required to provide a current satisfactory police check.
- 10. Must be comfortable to work in an environment with mammals, birds and reptiles including snakes.
- 11. Knowledge of the attractions of Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary would be an advantage.
