Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary (CWS) is located on the Southern end of Gold Coast. We are the largest attraction within the National Trust of Australia (Queensland) portfolio and feature a vibrant and varied collection of Australian Wildlife and Non-Native Exotics located one block back from beautiful Currumbin beach.

We are seeking a friendly and helpful Casual Train Driver to drive the famous Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary miniature train. This role involves driving a miniature train in a circuit around Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary in order to provide our guests with a special visitor experience. Duties will include queue management, delivery of commentary and enforcing safety instructions in a friendly manner. Other duties will include cleaning the train and assisting with other department tasks as required.

Details about this Position:

- This is a Casual role, working from 0-37 hours per week.
- Shifts will vary between 8.00am to 5:00pm (8 hours) or 11:00am to 3:00pm (4 hours).
- This role involves weekend and holiday work and may require work on selected Public Holidays.
- Full training will be provided to the successful candidate but relevant experience is required.
- You must be comfortable working in an outdoor environment that includes birds and reptiles.
- The successful applicant may be required to provide a satisfactory police check clearance.
- The pay rate and conditions are under Amusements, Events & Recreation Award 2010.
- Non smokers are preferred.

Selection Criteria:

1. Due to cabin size restrictions, applicants must be of small to medium stature, with a high standard of personal presentation.
2. Current manual driver's license essential, with some mechanical ability desirable.
3. Previous experience with driving a train or tourist transport vehicle will be highly regarded.
4. Genuine experience in a customer service role is essential – a high level of maturity and a calm manner is required to deal professionally with situations when the train is full, and disappointed passengers cannot board.
5. Can speak clearly and communicate in a friendly manner.
6. Ability to work comfortably and assist international visitors who may have limited English.
7. Physical capability to perform some heavy and awkward lifting i.e. to assist mobility impaired guests and parents with strollers / prams on the train.
8. Knowledge of and ability to adhere to WHS guidelines and policies.
9. Is capable in an emergency, and confident to undertake security responsibilities as required.
10. Can demonstrate a flexible, cooperative attitude.
11. You must have availability to work over Qld & NSW school holiday periods.
12. Knowledge of the attractions of Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary is desirable.
