First Aid - CWS has 3 First Aid posts in the park (Nature's Gift Photography Counter, Visitor Services and General Store - Wild Photos). First Aid trained staff are rostered within the Sanctuary at all times and have access to first aid kits located throughout CWS. First Aid response is conducted via two-way radios for efficiency and quick response. Education staff have first aid training and access to first aid kits.

Emergency Preparedness - Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary has extensive emergency procedures in place with two-way radio and mobile phone communications. Emergency / Fire Wardens will direct Student groups to evacuation points in case of an emergency. Evacuation points are the Lorikeet Arena and the Aboriginal Dance Area – Student groups must follow the directions given by staff or Wardens in case of emergency. Fire Evacuation plans and fire fighting equipment are located in all buildings.

Risk Ratings – True Risk is the assessed uncontrolled risk. Residual Risk is the risk that may still be left after control measures are implemented. Risk is assessed as 'L' – Low; 'M' – Moderate; 'H' – High; and 'E' – Extreme using a Risk Matrix. All control measures are regularly monitored and reviewed for effectiveness.
